Small-Sided Football - it's all about participation, skill development and fun

- Coaches should encourage players to pass and dribble rather than kick up-field or shoot for goal from anywhere.
- Coaches must not enter the field of play.
- Parents should offer the players encouragement but must not coach from the sidelines.
- Parents must not stand behind the goal line.
- Referees need to instruct players on how to play the game but must not coach their own team.
- No offside, but the referee can move players blatantly put in offside positions.
